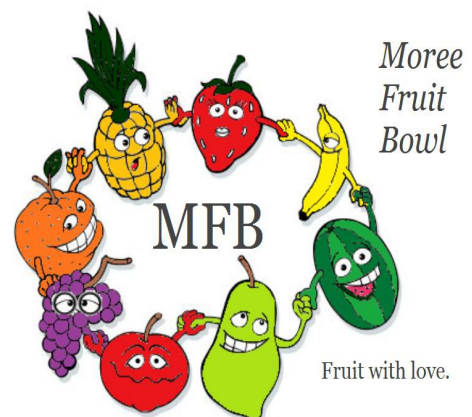

It is good to hear that Clarice has left hospital and has returned to her normal (busy) life. After many months in hospital we thank God for her recovery.

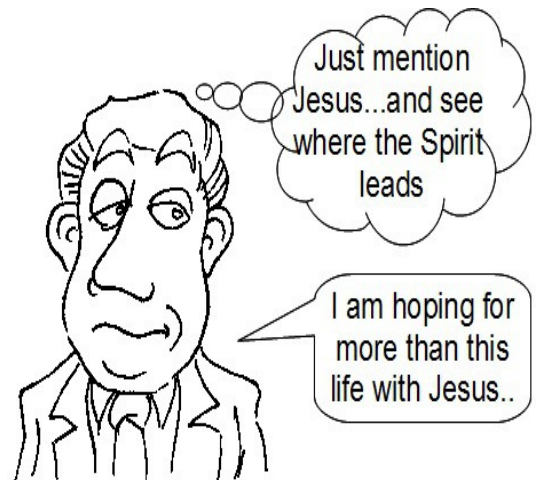
