

On the 20th January, we will be having a combined service with Doonside Church of Christ who will be coming to us.


A Note from Alison

Mission Project 2013 – Fulflude Ministry Training Centre (FMTC)

FMTC is a ministry training centre set up by SIM missionaries in the west African country of Niger in 2010. Its mission is to train Fulani believers to reach out to their own families and communities with the message of Jesus. It costs \$516 a year to train a student at



the centre. The goal is to see people trained to establish a vibrant, growing Fulani church across Niger. Our mission projects have traditionally set a target, not so much of money to raise, but of something tangible to achieve. Perhaps this time we could set ourselves the target of providing training for four people at the FMTC. This would mean raising \$2064 in 2013. That would equate to approximately \$38 a week over the course of a year. This would require sacrificial giving, over and above our regular support for our own church, but if 20 of us committed to giving up something that cost us \$2 a week we would easily reach our goal. CHRISTMAS IN THE FREE WEST

Whilst public schools in Sweden are by law non-confessional, Advent services are part of the compulsory curriculum. This year, however, the government has ruled that, though the Advent services are still compulsory, in public schools they must be Christ-less and prayer-less, to try to balance Sweden's Christian cultural tradition with the 'new secularism'. Last year the Scottish government promoted all Scotland's winter festivals except Christmas. This year the European Union

Commission published three million secondary school diaries that detailed the feasts, festivals and holidays of all faiths except Christianity, even omitting Christmas and Easter. The West has forgotten the Lord. Revival and returning to him are urgent or else anti-Christian repression, intolerance and hostility will only escalate. Please pray for a Christmas awakening in the West.
