Fulfulde Ministry Training Centre (FMTC) - The

Wodaabe are a nomadic people who make their home in the sandy, windswept margins of the Sahara Desert in modern-day Niger. They are a subgroup of the Fulani.

The Wodaabe roam the semi-arid regions of south western Niger and northern Nigeria. They live in the bush where the landscape consists of sand-swept plains, dusted with green in the rainy season and dotted by a few small trees. Despite the apparent isolation, people, camels, donkeys, sheep and goats appear out of nowhere! Visiting Wodaabe in the bush is not easy. The groups move about and are hard to find since their tracks disappear in the shifting sand.

Most Wodaabe are cattle herders and traders. Unlike some Fulani who have settled in towns over time, the Wodaabe remain nomadic, roaming between villages and wells in a constant search for water and grazing land. They trade dairy products as well as a uniquely woven and dyed fabric that brings a high price in markets across West Africa and around the world.

SIM is looking for more workers to serve the Wodaabe people, to live among them and share the good news of Jesus' love. Pray that the Lord would raise up workers to accomplish the task of evangelism and to disciple new Wodaabe Christians.
