Persecuted Believers

Iranian authorities continue to pressure churches of Armenian or Assyrian heritage to cancel all services in the Farsi language, or face permanent closure. Pastor Robert Asseriyan was arrested on May 21, two days after the church refused to voluntarily terminate its Farsi services. He is being held in Tehran's notorious Evin prison. "If the Iranian government manages to close this church, the few remaining churches that have Farsi-speaking services will follow." Historically, the Iranian government has tolerated Christians of predominantly Armenian or Assyrian descent and their churches. However, churches which refuse to stop Farsi services face opposition. Iran is No. 8 on the World Watch List of 50 countries where oppression of Christians is most severe. Source Worldwatch Monitor
