#4 Persecuted Country: Somalia

Terrorist groups such as al-Shabab are a threat to Christians and the general Muslim population. Christians made up of Muslim Background Believers (MBBs) and expatriate aid workers, face persecution from Islamic extremism. When MBBs are identified, they are eliminated and aid workers, Christian or otherwise, require tight security due to the risk of abduction. Maintained strictly as an Islamic state with no room for Christians. It is too dangerous to meet openly and families of converts are fearful that they might be suspected of conversion and risk execution.
