Snapshot of Westview

The church leadership are made up of Elders and Deacons. Both Elders and Deacons are people that have been recognised as meeting the biblical requirements found in 1 Tim 3 and Titus 1. Deacons are those whose servanthood the church has recognised, and whom it trusts to encourage the discipleship, stewardship and servanthood of the church. Elders (also called overseers, bishops or pastors) are those whom the church has recognised as called and equipped by God to tend the church, leading, guiding, teaching. Presently the Deacons are made up of Steve Kwan, Spike van Niekerk, Kath Johnson, Bob Stock, Lee Arundel (presently on sabbatical) and Tony Calman. For the purposes of further development and training, JJ is also meeting with the Elders and Deacons. The Elders meet each Tuesday night and the deacons join them every other Tuesday night. At these meetings the scriptures are studied and discussed, the leaders hold themselves accountable to each

other, issues related to the community are considered, concluding in prayer.

From the Open Doors' World Watch List we seek to pray for the persecuted church from rated most severe.

#19 Persecuted Country: Qatar

The state religion is conservative Islam and nearly all Qatari citizens are Sunni or Shia Muslims. Christian worship is only allowed in designated religious complexes, of which there are only two at the moment, which makes them easier to control and monitor. Many expat labourers are denied access to these complexes as they live too far away or are prevented from attending by employers. A Muslim who converts is considered an apostate and may face the death penalty. Foreign workers who evangelise non-Muslims are frequently deported.
