Praying for the Persecuted

From the Open Doors' World Watch List we seek to pray for the persecuted church.

#33 Persecuted Country: Mali

After the French military intervention in January 2013, the threat of Islamists has been averted, at least temporarily, but in the North there is still no normal church life possible and the Christians who fled are afraid to return. Mali has always been a typical West-African state with a (mostly) moderate Islam, constitutionally secular proscribing religious political parties, even though a high percentage of its population is Muslim. The situation changed with the proclamation of the creation of the independent state of Azawad in Northern Mali (April 2012). Among the less than 5% of Malians who are Christians, the majority are Roman Catholic, while there is also a significant number of Protestants. Even though most Malian Christians live in the south of the country, they feel threatened by the Islamists in the north.
