Faith is...

The relationship between knowledge, faith and belief can be vague in our thinking and it can be the source of endless discussion and dispute. In the Christian faith, we have a strong focus on teaching however it is not just our endeavour to acquire truth, our aim is to live in the truth. Everyone has a "faith": a life shaped by the knowledge that they accept to be true. It remains a "faith" because no human being can claim to possess and understand ultimate truth. The atheist will make an absurd claim of ultimate truth: 'there is no God', but how can they truly know that is truth? Do they know everything? Still, that "knowledge" shapes their life, so that is their faith.

Christian faith is not based on our knowledge of "ultimate" truth, but it is based upon the one that we believe does possess that ultimate truth: the Lord Jesus Christ. He knows and understands all things, so we allow him to shape our lives. This shaping of our lives is a life of faith. That is how we remain in him.

The scriptures do not explain everything that we might want to know, but it explains everything that we will need to know. So when hardship and difficulties come, we go back to what Jesus tells us, that God is good, he is sovereign over all things, and that he is bringing about his purposes so we can trust him even in the difficult times. Doesn't Paul commend the Thessalonians for a life shaped by the gospel message (2 Thes 1:1-11)? Lives shaped by the knowledge that Jesus is our Lord is the faith that is our aim as a community. Let's make that our personal aim and to encourage each other that way too!

Population: 11.1 million (Christian: Hundreds)

Main Religion: Islam

Main Source of Persecution: Islamic Extremism/Tribal Antagonism

What is it like for Christians in Somalia?

Persecution of Christians is severe in Somalia. With no functioning government, Christians are targeted by Islamic terrorists and clan authorities. However, as the government gains more control, state actors are joining to persecute Christians. Islamic religious leaders maintain publicly that there is no room for Christianity, Christians and churches in Somalia. Islam is the 'state religion', and Christianity is pushed away from public life. Islamic terrorists, such as al-Shabaab and other radical Islamic groups, have intensified their attack on Christians.

The only Christians in Somalia are those who have converted from a Muslim background, and new believers must hide their conversion to Christianity from everyone, even the own family or clan. Believers risk targeted violence from their family, clan, authorities or militias when their faith in discovered.

If International support decreases for Somalia once again, the future of the country in general, and for Christians in particular, will get worse.
