Pray for our Persecuted brothers and sisters

Country: Maldives

Leader: President Abdulla Yameen Abdul Gayoom

Population: 358,000

Main Religion: Sunni Muslim (official religion)

Government: Republic

Main Source of Persecution: Islamic Extremism

The situation

The Maldives is run by a government who sees itself as the protector of Islam, governing with laws that basically prohibit a Maldivian to convert to any religion other than Islam. The consequences of doing so includes losing citizenship. To be Maldivian is equated with being Muslim, so officially there are no Maldivian Christians, only ex-pat Christians. In February 2014, the Ministry of Islamic Affairs revealed key objectives to include blocking all religions except Islam and ensuring that all laws and regulations adhere to Islamic principles.

There are no church buildings and so the few Maldivian Christians, without room to meet, have to take all precautionary measures possible to avoid being discovered. Even tourists have reported getting into trouble having a personal copy of the Bible with them. Christians are deeply underground as they know about the consequences once they are discovered, though fortunately the level of violence is not very high.

Christians are portrayed negatively in media and do not have any place in the public square. Given the sternness of the government and the support it has from Maldivian citizens, the situation for the Christian minority is likely to remain the same.

Please pray for our brothers and sisters, and the nation of the Maldives.
