What is an elder/pastor?

"The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honour, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching." – 1 Timothy 5:17

The situation in the Kenya

Kenya has seen the most dramatic shift in persecution on the World Watch List this year - rising from 43 last year to 19. The reason for this jump is a significant rise in Islamic extremism, especially in Nairobi, Northeast, and Coastal regions. Throughout the majority of the country, Christians also experienced intensified pressure in all areas of life.

Homegrown radical Muslims and militants crossing the border from Somalia are severely persecuting Christians. The government has failed to adequately deal with the problem and perpetrators usually go unpunished.

The government is also pushing a secularist agenda, which impacts the Church in Kenya by opposing Christian values. Kenyan Christians will likely face deteriorating persecution if the government fails to intervene.
