The situation in India

All types of Christianity are affected by persecution in India, but Christian converts from a Hindu background and non-traditional Protestant groups are suffering most. A new Hindu government (in power since May 2014, led by Hindu hardliner Narendra Modi of the Bharatiya Janata Party, or BJP) is radicalising society. At the top level the influence of fundamentalist Hindus has increased. A number of states have adopted anti-conversion legislation. Hindu radicals have started monitoring Christian activity in much detail many of them have planted spies in churches.

Violence against Christians in India is rampant and occurs especially in the states where BJP is ruling. Reports on pastors and church members beaten up because of allegations of conversion are frequent, sometimes Christians are even killed. Since November 2013, church buildings as well as homes of Christians were destroyed and many converts had to flee their homes, including Christians of the 'untouchable' Dalit caste. Incidents of violence are increasing in number and occur almost daily.
