Jit and Jan, who we are supporting for our mission project this year, will be joining us this Sunday morning to share about their ministry in Thailand. "[Their] focus is on evangelism among the Pwo



Karen people group, and church development work with other Karen groups. They give some assistance to various wholistic ministries that seek to care for the sick, disabled and marginalised, and provide education and self-help for the local people. The Karen people are an ethnic minority (despite numbering up to eight million) in both Thailand and Burma. Many of the Sgaw Karen are Christians. The Pwo Karen, with a quite different dialect, have mostly adopted Buddhism, fusing it with their animistic spirit beliefs. They have been resistant to the Gospel yet ancient traditional stories can form bridges to understanding the message of Jesus. Jit has raised awareness of Pwo Karen traditions, stirring interest in culture and language and demonstrating that Christ seeks to work through culture, not destroy it. 30 congregations, mostly Sgaw Karen, that are scattered along the border between Thailand and Burma, have also valued Jit's assistance. Refugees from Burma and the little publicised conflict in that country are on the Yawans' doorstep. Jit and Jan help where possible."

Pray for our persecuted brothers and sisters

Main Source of Persecution: Islamic Extremism

The situation in the Palestinian Territories

The number of Christians is diminishing and the influence of radical Islam is growing. Partly as a result of their influence, Hamas takes Islamizing measures from time to time. Dynamics of Christian persecution in the Palestinian Territories are complex. Christians are squeezed in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict: their ethnicity entailing many restrictions from the Israeli side and their religion putting them in a minority position within the Palestinian community. Of all types of Christianity present in the Palestinian Territories, Christian converts from a Muslim background are persecuted the most, followed by all local Christian background believers (historical Christians and non-traditional Protestants) in Gaza.

Please pray:

- > For the many women in Israeli and Palestinian areas who suffer trauma from violence because of war and persecution because of their gender
- > For students at the Bethlehem Bible College preparing for Christian ministry and leadership
- > For the church in Gaza, as many are still suffering from the war in 2014
