# What has taken you captive? Christ or another?

We continue this week in our series through Paul's letter to the Colossian Christians. In this section (2:6-15), he reminds them (and us) to continue to live in Christ. Christians have been united to Christ through his life, death and resurrection. They have been brought spiritually from death to life. But there are threats to undermine the freedom that Christ has bought for us with his precious blood. The threat for the Colossians was philosophy and empty lies that were not according to the teaching they had received about Christ, but based on human traditions and demonic powers. Paul cautioned them to beware, lest they be taken captive by these falsehoods that were not according to the truth of the gospel they had received.

We live in a world where we face similar threats. Teachings that do not accord with the truth of the Scriptures, and the allurement of other things to take us captive. But Paul's encouragement to them is as true and needed for us: "as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving." To be taken captive by Christ, and our union with him, is to truly live and never look back.

## Pray for our persecuted brothers and sisters

**Country:** Brunei

Leader: Sultan and Prime Minister Sir Hassanal Bolkiah

Population: 429,000 thousand

Main Religion: Islam

**Government:** Constitutional Sultanate

Main Source of Persecution: Islamic Extremism

In Brunei, contact with Christians in other countries, the import of Bibles and the public celebration of Christmas are banned. Sharia law has been fully implemented since 2011 for all Muslims in the country. The government has followed a plan of Islamisation among the tribal people: in May 2014, Sharia law was extended to penal law and will be introduced in three steps. The first step includes fines for indecent behaviour or failure to attend Friday prayers. A second phase will include corporal punishment for theft and other crimes. The final phase, to be introduced in 2015, will see capital punishment for crimes like adultery.

Included in the first phase is that Christians proclaiming their faith can be fined, imprisoned or face sentences. Only the Anglican and Roman Catholic churches are recognized, but even they have to be very careful. They are able to hold services, but apart from that, their functioning is restricted. Unregistered churches, which in most cases belong to the non-traditional Protestant Christians, are considered to be 'illegal sects' and consequently closed or at least restricted and monitored.

Christian converts from Islam have to operate largely underground, while converts with a Malay background face intense pressure - as it is not only illegal, but also a huge disgrace for the family and community.
