As we continue through Colossians this week (2:16-23), Paul encourages the Christians at Colossae to again not be led astray by these false teachers. These teachers are not holding fast to Christ the Head of the body. They pointed to the shadows of the Jewish law, that were pointing to Christ, who is the reality, the fulfilment, that the shadows pictured. They pointed to other things that had become a religion of observance and of false humility. They were not holding up Christ, and believers being united to Him, as the focus and the reality. The true gospel that had come to the church and the gospel that they have believed.

Even if our problem today isn't holding onto laws about days and foods that we should keep or should not eat, we are faced with challenges every day in our lives to choose between making other things our focus, our aim and our reliance to be right before God. We can make doing or not doing certain things the basis for our acceptance before God. The truth is, it can only ever be by being united to Christ in his death and resurrection for us, that we can find forgiveness, peace, and eternal life. Will you follow after shadows? Or will you follow after Christ, the Reality? Because Jesus Christ is the the Only Way to true rest and peace. He is the reality. It's all about Him.

Pray for our persecuted brothers and sisters

Country: Laos

Leader: President Lt Gen. Choummali Saignason

Population: 7 million Main Religion: Buddhism

Government: Communist State

Main Source of Persecution: Tribal Antagonism

The practice of Animism is still strong in Laos, especially in rural areas. Tribal leaders and villagers who practice Animism see Christianity as a foreign element which may anger the spirits who protect the village. Refusal to follow rituals can lead to corporal punishment or being banned from the village. To keep everything under control, the local authorities and the country's communist party put enormous pressure on the small Christian minority. It considers Christians to be 'foreign agents' of a Western ideology that challenges communism.

Only a limited number of registered Christian congregations are allowed to have services - 'illegal' church meetings can be raided and all Christian materials confiscated. Only the Lao Evangelical Church and the Roman Catholic Church are permitted to hold biblical training, so Christians in remote areas especially suffer from a lack of leadership and Bible study. Christian materials, including Bibles, can neither be published in the country nor imported. Every movement of Christians is monitored and if the state considers it necessary, hindered. If converts from a Buddhist or Animist background are identified, especially in rural areas, they are initially put under pressure - for example, they face threats of their children being poisoned or excluded from school and local facilities. If the converts insist on staying loyal to their Christian faith, many are then forced to leave their homes and community.
