## **Secrets of the Kingdom**

The Bible presents the truth that, left to themselves, humans are lost. It also tells us that the Lord Jesus came to 'seek and to save the lost.' (Luke 19:10)

Jesus told his followers that they learnt secrets of the Kingdom through his parables. The passage from which our teaching comes today (Luke 14:7-17:10) includes at least 8 parables and we will be looking at 3 of them, which all deal with being lost. They show that some people are lost and don't believe it, some are lost and don't know it and some are lost and know it.

At one time or another all of us fell into one or another of those descriptions. Understanding what it means to be lost and how it can be fixed is the difference between eternity with God or without God; of heaven or hell.

There is a way back to God and all heaven joins in celebrating when lost people agree with God about their lostness, coming to Jesus for forgiveness and entry into his Kingdom.

### **Continued suffering for minorities**

Indonesia is a diverse country that claims to be tolerant to all religions, however religious minorities continue to suffer and Christians face problems in registering church buildings. Christians have at times even suffered violent attacks. Islamic by-laws are in place in some regions and territories, with Aceh province ruled by Sharia law.

### **Diversity and disunity**

Indonesia is well-known as being the biggest Muslim country in the world. With a population of over 260.5 million citizens, 86 per cent of whom are Muslim. The Portuguese came to Indonesia in 1511, and brought with them Catholicism. Christianity became a major religion in eastern Indonesia, whereas Islam maintains a strong hold in the western and central parts.

### Islam is deeply entrenched

As Islam is deeply entrenched in much of Indonesia, converts to Christianity always have to be careful in the way they worship, especially if they are the only believers in their family. In mid-October 2015 at least nine churches in the province of Aceh were forcibly closed and broken down while two others were torched. An additional 13 churches have been given six months to apply for building permission.
