A rise in radical Islam

Bahrain is back on the World Watch List for 2016 due to a rise in Islamic Extremism in the country and Islamic State's influence in the region. This rise has added further tension and restriction to a nation where freedoms were already limited by authoritarian rule.

Relationships under pressure

According to some traditions, Christianity in Bahrain preceded Islam. However, the development of churches and Christian communities did not come until late 19th century due to the dominance of the Turkish Empire.

In the early and mid-20th century, efforts were made to establish new churches in Bahrain. Social and political instability though in recent years, has hindered the growth of Christianity. Relations between Muslims and Christians are under increasing pressure.

Permitted but unwelcome

Expatriate Christians are relatively free to worship but the number of church compounds is limited, so dozens of congregations must use the same building.

Christians who have converted from Islam face many challenges. For example, public school curriculums include Islamic teachings. Christians are not obliged to take the courses but anyone who is suspected of conversion is discriminated against. So converts who do not want to reveal their new Christian faith for their safety are still required to attend the Islamic teaching.

Please Pray:

- > That the Church in Bahrain would continue to flourish and grow, despite the pressure placed upon it by the government and the rise of radical Islam.
- > For Christians from Muslim backgrounds, that they would have faith in God's goodness when they face challenges.
- > For tensions to ease between Muslims and Christian so the gospel can be shared.
