## Pray for our persecuted brothers and sisters

Country: Niger

Leader: President Issoufou Mahamadou Population: 18 million

Main Religion: Islam Government: Republic Main Source of Persecution: Islamic Extremism

#### **Small population of Christians**

More than 98% of the population in Niger are Muslims. Only an estimated 2% of the population are Christian, the majority being Catholic. Believers in Niger face persecution from Islamic extremism, as there is a growing influence of radical Islam in the country. Extremist group Boko Haram also operates in the country.

#### **Islamic extremism increasing**

Even though a high percentage of Niger's population is Muslim; religion is understood to be a private matter and generally steers clear of politics. There are now indications, however, that the separation of religion and state is increasingly under pressure. Radical Muslim clerics of the Izala group are present, who are known to be a radical group (also operate in Nigeria). Izala and other extremist groups create pressure on minority religions and on Muslims they consider to be deviating from their version of Islam.

#### **Attacks on churches**

In 2015, there were a number of violent attacks against Christians. At least 82 churches, Christian schools, houses and orphanages were destroyed, 70 in January 2015 during the Charlie Hedbo attacks. At least 2,000 believers were threatened and forced to leave their homes during January 2015 alone. Christians in Niger have never been attacked at this scale. Christians face discrimination mainly from their community and family. Converts to Christianity are seen as a threat, and believers are persecuted by their family members as their new faith is made known. Nigerian terrorist group Boko Haram are continuing to cross Nigerian borders into neighbouring Niger, Cameroon and Chad, with the objective of implementing Sharia law in these countries.
