Baptist Accreditation

JJ has taken the first two steps in the process towards being accredited as a Baptist Pastor in NSW & ACT. Last Wednesday after a Preliminary Registration Interview (Stage 2) he has been given permission to make the application for accreditation (Stage 3), and last Thursday he commenced his accreditation studies at GWFC College. Baptist Union accreditation is a very thorough process and one that will continue for a few years.

After Stage 3 is completed he will undergo an interview process which normally takes the best part of a day, and if successful will move to being an accreditation candidate (Stage 4) where he will be on a probation period for at least 12 months. Continue to pray for JJ and Soona as they move through this process.

Telecommunications Tower Public Meeting

The meeting with the public regarding the telecommunication tower took place last Monday night. It was a resounding success. People came to voice their concerns and we had an opportunity to meet the community. There were many good contacts as 20 people from the public came. It would be fair to say that there were a few that came to speak strongly against the tower. The main fears were focused on land values and health concerns which were based more on perception than scientific fact. We thank Lee who did a remarkable job in leading the meeting. The company representative did a remarkable job too.

The discussion among the church members who did attend seems to be consistent: that going ahead with the tower would work against our mission (to make passionate disciples of Jesus) and our purpose (to bring glory to God). The Elders agree and recommend that we <u>do not proceed</u> with the tower, but thank the company for their interest, commend their staff who worked with us, and look for opportunities to make known the decision in the local community. If anyone has a strong opposing position, please talk to the Elders.
