

# Up and Coming Sundays

This Sunday we continue our series in Daniel to Chapter 5 where we see God bring swift judgement upon King Belshazzar for his pride and arrogance. The idea of God cutting short life in an act of judgment is not well received in the modern era, but one that we will consider today as we come to the teaching. Someone helpful wrote:

"God is sovereign over all of life and can take it whenever He sees fit. God and God alone can give life, and God alone has the right to take it whenever He so chooses. In fact, He ultimately takes every person's life at death. It is not our life to begin with but God's... God is under no obligation to extend anyone's life for even another day. How and when we die is completely up to Him."

The following week will resume our teaching in Daniel focusing on Chapter 6. We do encourage people to read ahead in preparation for the teaching.



# Westview Review and Planning (WRAP)

The church meets specifically to seek the mind of God to consider the life of our church in February, June, October each year. The next WRAP meeting will be held on October 9th after our regular morning service. The meeting duration is usually for 60-90 minutes. Many churches only allow formal members (see the note in the bulletin explaining the difference) to attend such meetings and have an input. It has been our practice to encourage anyone who considers Westview their home to join with us. We want to encourage all to come as we believe each person is a valuable member of our church community.

This meeting we have some important issues to address which have been made known previously. We ask anyone with concerns to raise them directly with the Elders, so that if a recommendation does come to a meeting, concerns have already been heard and addressed. If you would like to raise any concerns, we ask that they be raised earlier rather than later with the Elders.

Recommendation from the Special Target Group: "That Westview Baptist Church recognise God's gift to us of Tony and Lynne Kenning for the office of deacon and that we have a service to set them apart for this role".

Recommendation from the Elders/Deacons: As a covenant community of faith and conforming to our previous practice, we should enter into a covenant of grace with JJ and Soona Bomford, called by God and with the encouragement of the whole church community, serving our church in full time ministry and a new covenant with Tony and Wendy in their new roles in a broader ministry with other churches. We ask that your input prior to this matter be addressed to either Lee, Kath or Steve, not to Tony, Wendy, JJ or Soona directly. # Membership at Westview Baptist

One of the distinctives of a Baptist church is that the final authority of the church does not lay with the leaders but the church members [Matthew 18:15-17] as they seek to discern the will of God from the Scriptures. From 1 Corinthians 5, it is the church that disciplines a person who continues in sin and in 2 Corinthians 6, it is the church that welcomes people back. In Galatians, the church is to judge



good doctrine and truth [1:6,7]. That does not deny that the body of Christ who are dependent upon each other [1 Peter 2:4,5] are also to trust their leaders that they have recognised and submit to their authority [Hebrews 13:17]. The church are to follow their leaders while they continue following Christ [1 Cor 11:1].

Westview has always been inclusive of all who come and join with us, never focusing on those who are "members" and those who are "non-members". For whatever reason, if a person does not wish to be a formal member, we don't wish to make any distinction.

It is helpful in two ways to maintain a membership role:

- 1. It is the clearest expression of a person's intention to journey with us.
- 2. Without a membership role we are not recognised by the government and therefore we cannot own property nor have a church bank account.

For these reasons, membership is important and worth considering. If you have any other questions or would like to consider formal church membership, please talk to one of the Elders who can discuss it further with you.
