


Faithful Followers in a Foreign Land

We continue our series on Daniel and we come to the part where many churches no longer preach and most Sunday Schools lessons avoid. The inspirational stories of Chapters 1-6 are now replaced with dark and confusing dreams and visions of Chapter 7-12. One of the reasons churches do not preach on these chapters is the unwise applications which has often left division within churches, applications which were often proven to be incorrect.



Seeking to avoid these pitfalls, consider from our overview diagram how similar Daniel's dreams were to Nebuchadnezzar's dream. Indeed, the message is almost the same, though Daniel's dream gives greater insight and it's as though these very human stories of Chapters 1-6 now prepares us for what God is doing in heavenly realms. God gives the Scriptures for the encouragement and comfort of his people, yet apocalyptic (a word which means 'to reveal' which describes this section) often fills the Christian with fear and anxiety. Did God get it wrong or are we reading it incorrectly?

It is our hope that today's teaching will help you see the horrors of our world in which we live are overwhelmed by our confidence in Jesus Christ our Lord. It does require eyes of faith. We can't afford to be like Nicodemus to whom Jesus said, "I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things?" (John 3:16).
