



Daniel 10-12

There is much going on in Daniel 10-12 that can leave us a little confused; we can take courage that Daniel did not understand everything either (12:8). Daniel is given a picture of some of the great suffering that will come upon the people of God, suffering that history records did come and suffering that will continue to come.

As the people of God, how then are we to live in the midst of suffering and persecution? How are we to face tomorrow and the days to come when we have been told in fact that as

God's people we will continue to suffer and how very great it will be (12:1)? Here in Daniel 10-12 we are encouraged to

'stand firm and take action', to seek to make others understand the truth. Ultimately our certain hope comes not from escaping suffering

today or tomorrow but escaping the eternal shame and disgrace that all who reject God will face on that great Day (12:2).

God has promised His people, those who trust in Jesus, 'everlasting life' where they will 'shine like the brightness of the...
