Matthew's Gospel

This Sunday we move into the Gospel of Matthew. This is such wonderful book. Matthew particularly shows us how Jesus is the fulfillment and continuation of the whole of the biblical story of God and His people. He highlights Jesus as the Messiah – the King,



Jesus as the New Moses, and Jesus as Immanuel – God with us. Sometimes we might think of the Old Testament and New as so different and at odds to each other...but that is just not the case. All of the Old Testament is pointing forward, it is showing us the problem, showing us the new, showing us the promises

and patterns of God's redemption for His people. His salvation that we see in part – rescuing His people. But ultimately it is all pointing forward. From the Garden of Eden to the Exile of Israel there are promises of restoration, of hope, of salvation...of One who would come... A King. A Saviour. We see a picture of sin, of humanity...

...in our utter rebellion against this God who made us. We see that in our own hearts today. But we see this promise... look for example at Psalm 130:

¹ "Out of the depths I cry to you, O LORD; ² O Lord, hear my voice. Let your ears be attentive to my cry for mercy. ³ If you, O LORD, kept a record of sins, O Lord, who could stand? ⁴ But with you there is forgiveness; therefore you are feared. ⁵ I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, and in his word I put my hope. ⁶ My soul waits for the Lord more than watchmen wait for the morning, more than watchmen wait for the morning. ⁷ O Israel, put your hope in the LORD, for with the LORD is unfailing love and with him is full redeemption. ⁸ He himself will redeem Israel from all their sins."

The psalmist says God Himself will redeem His people from all their sins...

How would he do this? By sending the Lamb of God, the sacrifice to pay for our sins... By sending the King to deliver and to rule and reign forever over His people forever... the whole of God's Word points to Jesus the Christ, the King over all.
