As people of hope we should look to passages such as these for encouragement and with excitement. They should not cause us anxiety or fear. The emphasis of Jesus teaching in these chapters is preparedness and watchfulness.

Dramatic events have, are and will take place, terrible things will happen and people will be more than tempted to abandon their faith in Jesus, but for the follower of Christ our confidence is in the promises and truth of His word, that "...he who stands firm to the end will be saved."

Thanks to Gina for the lovely Easter banner she made which is online as an advertisement and which is also available to be handed out to people as an invitation.






New Morning Tea Sheet
