# Request from KINDERCARE to use CHURCH PROPERTY: Update & Meeting Scheduled for JANUARY 20th

Following a recent meeting with a town planner at Blacktown City Council (Lee attended this meeting) Kindercare have been informed by the council that the next step in the process is gaining approval for use of the hall from our church for their homework club and vacation care activities.

For this purpose, we will hold a church meeting on Sunday January 20th, 2019 after the morning service. We are not wanting to pre-empt any result from our meeting together on the 20th but are keeping you informed as to the timing of things.

Should our meeting on the 20th approve this matter, Kindercare would have to lodge the result of the meeting with council along with a plan of the church property and a statement that informs council that regular worship services would not be impacted by these activities.

Once again, should the meeting approve this proposal it would initially be for a **6 month probationary period**, after which time both Westview and Kindercare would review how things went before any extension of the contract would take place.

Please continue to pray about this matter and ask for clarification from JJ, Lee or the Deacons should you have any concerns or questions.
