Bible-Centered Teaching

Over the next 10 weeks or so we will be going through a series looking at who we are as a church family.

Years ago we looked at the scriptures and we asked one another who we are, what we value, and what we are about. We also asked: what do we want to see by God's grace?

And that affirmation is our vision statement. It speaks of our **purpose**, of our **mission**, of our **values** and of our **vision** as a church.

Last week we looked at our Purpose, Mission and Strategy towards this for 2019. But what are the defining values of our church as we seek to be passionate disciples of Jesus in western Sydney to the glory of God? One of the characteristics of the early church was the devotion to **the apostles' teaching**. The **psalms** are full of encouragement for us to love the word of God and the **epistles** enthusiastically commend the preaching of God's word.
