INTERNSHIPS for 2019

The church internship program, a partnership with Greater West for Christ (GWFC) and Morling College begun last year. This is an intentional relationship between GWFC and the local church to ministry experience with theological training facilitate relationships with other churches in Western Sydney.

The GWFC training hub provides a weekly gathering of students (on Thursdays) where in the context of community those who attend have the opportunity to share, learn and to grow together in relationship and service for the Kinadom of God as they study different Bible college subjects.
