PARTNERING with the **DOONSIDE FOOD PANTRY**

JJ connected this week with **Lei Toetu** who runs a free food pantry stall at the corner of **Coveny St and Hill End Rd** (a less than 5 minute walk up the road from the church property).

Lei grew up in a Maori community in New Zealand where he saw community/relationships in action, but when he moved to Doonside he noticed this was lacking, so his heart was to change this. So he has been running this pantry for a number of months now and more recently a library stall too. The food is provided through charities and community donations and Lei enjoys having friendly conversation with the people in the area who pass by or drop in.

JJ and Lei have had some great **chats about ways in which our church could partner with him.** We have spoken about community BBQ's and providing food for students in the local high school.



One thing that we can do straight away is to help provide food for the pantry. If you would like to donate anything you can bring it on a Sunday morning and we will have someone drop it off to Lei on behalf of the church after the service.

We really see God in this; it provides concrete ways in which we can **express love for our local community** and seek to build relationships with them. Please join us in praying God's blessing on this partnership and on Lei in his endeavour to serve and bless our community in this way.
