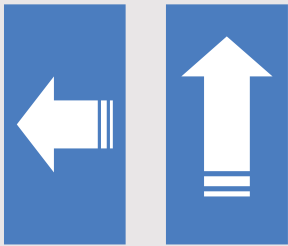
Combined Churches of Doonside Service: JUNE 30th @ 10am
